






SAIS Delivery Overview

Clinics offered in early Autu September for vulnerable ammer Term children (dependent on Term vaccine availability). Nasal Flu and Further clinics in October School Inactivated Flu half-term and start of offered to all Xmas holidays. revisits – all Catch up opportunities vaccines offered in schools and (except Flu) all Schools and clinics offered until the end of Year 11. ernative Spring Term **DTP / Men ACWY offered** All Year 9 students invited for DTP / Jan – Feb Men ACWY vaccinations and any **HPV / MMR offered** student in Year 10 or 11 still requiring the vaccines. All Year 8 students invited for HPV vaccine and any student in Year 9 -11 who still require the vaccine

Summary

NASAL FLU

All Reception To Year 11 Children (Up To 18 Years In Special Schools) Offered In School. Inactivated Injectables Offered Through Parental Choice Or Contraindication To LAIV.

All Children Able To Access Clinics (Usually Oct ½ Term And Xmas Holidays). No Routine School Revisits. At Risk / Vulnerable Children Prioritised For Early Clinics.

MMR

All Year 8 children without 2 confirmed Doses of MMR invited to book for SAIS vaccination at school (alongside HPV) or clinic session.

Any Year 9 -11 Child

Missing MMR Dose

(Identified

Opportunistically) Can Be

Seen In School / Clinic.

HPV

All Year 8 Children Invited To A School Vaccination Session For Single HPV Dose*(unless Immuno-compromised). If They Miss This Session, They Are Invited By SAIS To A Mop Up Session.

DTP / Men ACWY

All Year 9 Children Invited To A School Vaccination Session For DTP / Men ACWY Dose. If They Miss This Session, They Are Invited By SAIS To A Mop Up Session.




