Why did the IGPM start?

- No representative body for practice or PCN managers despite the scope and responsibility of our roles
- Overlooked for the New to Partnership Scheme
- No collective voice with government or policy makers, like NHS England, or with suppliers, like PCSE
- No professional accreditation or public register for managers

Who can apply and how do I join?

- Any Manager can join via the website or by scanning the QR code
- This gives you Associate membership and any Manager working in General practice can apply, including:
 - Practice Managers
 - PCN Managers
 - Business Managers
 - Operations Managers
 - Assistant/Deputy Managers
 - Managers of a specific function with a higher level of accountability /responsibility (e.g. finance manager, HR manager)
 - Managing in a scaled model incorporating general practices e.g. GP federation, Primary Care Network



Accreditation



To be eligible you must:

- Be a Manager in General Practice for not less than 2 years
- Finance Manager, Operational Manager, Assistant Practice Manager, PCN Manager
- Not be in breach of any article in the IGPM Membership Document
- having a conflict of interest, investigated for a criminal offence etc
- Must not be in any pending or active disciplinary action at the time of application.
- And of course, be a currently paid member of The IGPM
