

Vision, Aims & Priorities



Vision

To create a Primary Care Collaborative that has parity of voice, esteem, and influence across Devon ICS.

Purpose

Strengthen the voice of General Practice within the Integrated Care System (ICS).

Act in the interests of the wider Devon health and care system.

Understand and support the issues facing General Practice.

Promote the interests and sustainability of General Practice.

Facilitate collaboration among Primary Care Networks (PCNs) in Devon.

Input into the design of consistent patient pathways across the county, taking into account local variation and equality of access.

Work towards developing an integrated wider Primary Care strategy, including Pharmacy, Optometry, and Dentistry.

Aims

- Support Devon ICB and the wider ICS in making a case for sustainable investment in General Practice.
- Work with Devon ICB to develop an integrated Primary Care strategy, including the involvement of Pharmacy, Optometry, and Dentistry.
- Ensure sustained General Practice clinical and management leadership in all system workstreams from design to completion.
- Contribute towards developing a sustainability plan for General Practice, including developing models which reflects local variation and models of delivery.
- Promote collaborative leadership to create resilience and sustainability in General Practices.
- DCB will engage with and have equity of influence alongside all other Provider Collaboratives.

Priorities for the first 18 months

-Engagement, Visibility, and Presence: Strengthen relationships with Devon LMC and wider NHS stakeholders.

•Appointment of Workstream Leads: Appoint workstream leads to align with the 5 ICB core workstreams, as identified in the MOU.

•Framework Approval: Sign off on this operating framework, with the understanding that it is a work in progress to be revisited as a standing agenda item.

 Funding Secured: Identify and secure funding resources for at least the first 18 months, aiming for recurring and additional funding as appropriate.

•Support Roles Appointed: Appoint support roles to provide infrastructure for workstream leads where funding allows.

- Establish DCB as an operating entity in its own right: with the ability to independently manage finance, HR and governance.
